Scoring System: Each week, teams will play 9 holes to create a combined team score. That total will be ranked against the field to score points based on field size and a progressive multiplier. Week 1 is 1x week 2 is 2x and so on through week 7. Week 8 is 10x. Scorecard Submissions: 12 teams are in the field, points would be awarded as follows: 1st place wins 12, 2nd place 11, 3rd place 10, and so on through last place. If it were week 4, all points would be multiplied by 4, week 7 would have a 7x multiplier

Terms and Conditions

Entry Fee: \$225 (discounted from \$250 for first-time league participants).

 Fee includes 8 weeks of competition, access to league specials, and prizes for top performers.

Participation Requirements:

Players are expected to commit to all 8 weeks or notify organizers in advance if they
will miss any rounds. Missing more than 2 weeks without proper notice may result in
disqualification from the final standings.

Pace of Play:

• Players are required to adhere to the 2-hour round limit. Failure to maintain pace may result in penalty strokes or disqualification from that week's event.

Equipment:

- All players must use standard golf equipment compliant with USGA regulations.
- Players found to be using illegal equipment may face disqualification.

Scoring and Integrity:

- Scores must be submitted on the same night the round was completed. Each
 player's score must be verified by at least one other player in their group.
- Any disputes regarding scoring or conduct will be reviewed by Golf VX League Operations, whose decision will be final.

Prizes and Tiebreakers:

- Prizes will be awarded to the Top Finisher for Points and Top Finisher for Gross
 Average in the standings at the end of the 8 weeks.
- If there is a tie in the final points, the winner will be determined by comparing final round scorecards from holes 18-1.

Player Conduct: Players are expected to conduct themselves professionally. Any unsportsmanlike behavior, such as cheating, excessive drinking, or disruption, could result in disqualification and removal from the league.
