



Winter Session #2 2025 | Open League Overview

Number of Players: Limited. Up to 44 participants per session

Days & Times: Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday Nights (6PM-8PM and 8PM-10PM options)

Start Date: Monday, March 10th – Wednesday, March 12th 2025

Team Size: One, two, three, or four golfers per team (4 per bay) in competition

Format: Handicaps adjusted weekly with scores averaged for team size

Season Schedule: 8-Weeks with majors and a Championship Round in week 8

Payment: \$225 per player to be paid at the venue, week one

Prizes For:

- Points Leader
- Points Runner Up
- Low Gross Avg

Week 8	April 28-30	Championship – 8x Points

Pairings, Substitutions, and Make-Ups:

- Four golfers in each bay, paired up with other teams depending on occupancy.
- No need to find subs if you can't make it! If at least one team member plays, your team can post a score for that week. Sub scores cannot count without handicap.
- If nobody from your team can make it, you can complete the round during normal business hours by booking a bay or coming in on your membership.
- Designated league bays are first come first serve.

Scoring System:

- Each week, golfers will play 9 holes to create a combined team score.
- Scores are then adjusted based on the number of players on the team.
- The adjusted score is then handicapped and ranked against the field from all Open League sessions to earn points.

- Points for each week's net average rankings will be awarded based on the number of teams in the field and a progressive weekly multiplier.
- For example, if there are 20 teams in the field 1st place would get 20 points, 2nd place 19, and so on through 20th place, the highest net team total.
- Each week will be progressively weighted with the multiplier increasing by 1x weekly. Week 2 will be 2x points, week three 3x points and so on through week 8 at 8x. The only week that differs is week 1 which will be 3x and based on gross rank.

Scoring:

- Team scores should be reported each night to the front desk
- Staff will fill out a scorecard with the team captain name and score
- This is then input into a sheet which updates onto the leaderboard online

Terms and Conditions

Entry Fee:

- \$225 – includes 2 hours of weekly playtime for 8 weeks, a great environment for competition and camaraderie, access to league specials, and prizes for top performers!

Participation Requirements:

- Players are expected to commit to all 8 weeks or notify organizers in advance if they will miss any rounds. Missing more than 2 weeks without proper notice may result in disqualification from the final standings.

Finishing on-time:

- Players are required to adhere to the 2-hour round limit. Please be ready and use the skip player button if necessary. Failure to finish the round this window will result in your team being holed out with double bogies unless you decide to make it up on your own time.

Equipment:

- All players must use standard golf equipment compliant with USGA regulations.
- Players found to be using illegal equipment may face disqualification.

Scoring and Integrity:

- Scores should be submitted **on the same night** the round was completed. If scores are not collected, we can go retroactively in the app to view and post to the leaderboard.
- Any disputes regarding scoring or conduct will be reviewed by Golf VX Leagues, whose decision will be final.

Prizes and Tiebreakers:

- Prizes will be awarded to the **Top Finisher and Runner Up for Points** as well as **Top Finisher for Gross Average** in the standings at the end of the 8 weeks.
- If there is a tie in the final points, the winner will be determined by comparing final round scorecards from holes 9-1.

Player Conduct: Players are expected to conduct themselves professionally. Any unsportsmanlike behavior, such as cheating, excessive drinking, or disruption, could result in disqualification and removal from the league.
